Yesterday's plenary talk was a well-articulated and highly interesting discussion on heavy particle collisions given by Henrik Cederquist. He began with an introduction to his life in Stockholm, and his daily bicycle route to work.

Henrik then moved on to a brief background into the importance of ions and ionic collisions in medical radiation therapy, astrophysics (including in understanding star formation) and chemistry, and then progressed through to different types of collisions, and then to spectroscopic identification of both ions and ionic collisions. He gave particular attention to the mechanisms of fullerene creation in the universe and the possibility of it involving polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons.
